MERCY CRUSADE SPAY & NEUTER AND WELLNESS CLINIC RECEIVES \$48,160 FROM PETSMART CHARITIES® TO BOOST SPAY AND NEUTER EFFORTS IN OXNARD, VENTURA COUNTY

Mercy Crusade is excited to announce it received \$48,160 from PetSmart Charities, the leading funder of animal welfare in North America, to boost spay and neuter efforts in Ventura County!

The support of PetSmart Charities, the leading funder of animal welfare in North America, will enable Mercy Crusade to expand our efforts for low-cost spay and neuter services, and to reach families that can't otherwise afford services. Mercy Crusade Spay & Neuter Program has been in operation since 2001 and it is the only affordable non-profit spay, neuter veterinary clinic in a service area with approximately 70,000 active households in the client base. The Wellness Clinic which opened in 2011 has been a highly successful complement to our services. Overall, households represent about 150,765 pets assisted through Mercy Crusade in Ventura County. This project will significantly improve our capacity to facilitate positive

interactions between residents and animals, and it would have a positive influence upon the health of the community. There are minimal resources available to those working diligently to help their companion animals and rescue animals. There remains a high need in the areas of public awareness/education about the importance of spaying, neutering, and medical care to extend life for pets in the areas we serve. Mercy Crusade Spay, Neuter and Wellness Clinic provides services to the City of Oxnard, which includes two naval bases: Port Hueneme and Point Mugu. Additionally, we serve the growing communities of Simi Valley, Moorpark, Santa Paula, Piru, Fillmore and Camarillo.

We are extremely grateful for this grant, as we have worked for years to spay and neuter animals within the greater Ventura County community servicing companion pets that need an affordable outlet to extend the life of their pets and prevent pet overpopulation.

Not only is Mercy Crusade Spay & Neuter and Wellness Clinic making spay and neuter services accessible, they are striving to educate members of the community on its benefits and how it can ultimately decrease unplanned litters and prevent pet homelessness in the area,” said Jenny Aho, regional relationship manager at PetSmart Charities. “By doing so, they have proven to be a true advocate for local pets in need.” PetSmart Charities aims to proactively prevent pet homelessness through increased spay and neuter efforts.
